May 15, 2023**

Chairman Kluss called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss, Rasmussen, and Helgevoid.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoid to approve the tentative agenda with item 10 including drainage districts eligible for spread waivers. Motion carries.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of May 8, 2023 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoid to approve the cigarette permit for Caseys General Store in Dows. Motion carries.

Motion by Helgevoid and seconded by Rasmussen to approve Gardiner and Company PC proposal for the Wright County Audits for 2023, 2024, and 2025. Motion carries. The cost for the 2023 audit will be \$42,650, for the 2024 audit it will be \$44,800, and for the 2025 audit it will be \$47,050.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, presented the name of the new hire for the Heavy Equipment Operator in the Bridge and Sign Maintenance Facility. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the hire of the name presented pending post offer, pre-employment physical/drug screen and background check. Motion carries. The starting wage will be \$26.71 per hour.

Clemons gave an update on the Secondary Roads. There were 17 work orders completed last week. Blades are continuing to prep and level the rock miles. The year 3 rock rotation is 34.38% complete with 33 of the 96 segments completed. Crews are beginning the 310th Street rehab/reclaim today.

Mike Bowman, Clarmond County

Club Board, and board members of Clarmond Country Club spoke with the Supervisors for explanation on parcel 0709451002 that was conveyed to the State of Iowa on March 27th. Bowman stated that Clarmond has paid property taxes on that parcel since 1926. Kluss explained the Iowa Law that names all the sovereign lakes in the State of Iowa. With that parcel being a sovereign lakebed, that is considered State property. In 2016, the State of Iowa did a survey and claimed the parcel with photographs from the 1930s showing the original road and original lake shore. Kluss will set up a meeting with Bowman and the State of Iowa for further information.

Kristine Paradise, Senior Construction Tech for Snyder & Associates, is asking for sponsorship for her time, mileage, and lodging to attend the PHMSA (Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration) meeting. Paradise is looking for \$250 to \$300 from each county she is representing for the Summit Carbon Solutions pipeline.

Clark Morgan, Agronomy Manager at Gold-Eagle Cooperative, presented the proposal for the new anhydrous ammonia facility. This will be north of Clarion at the new grain facility behind the bins. Morgan has had discussions with Wright County Planning & Zoning. Motion by Helgevoid and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the proposal presented by Clark Morgan from Gold Eagle Cooperative for the new anhydrous ammonia site north of Clarion. Motion carries.

The Board of Supervisors will act as Drainage Trustees for the following Drainage District Assessments and Hearing.

Courtney Morris, Wright County Drainage Clerk, presented the 2023 Drainage Districts eligible to be spread per Iowa code 468.57 for

no less than 10 and no more than 20 years. The board then reviewed and took action on the following 9 eligible districts spreading each of them per the Iowa code.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoid to approve the 2023 Drainage District assessments eligible to be spread; 4 districts being spread for 10 years each and 5 districts being spread for 15 years each. Motion carries. Morris presented the following 2023 joint assessment with Webster County:

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the Joint Drainage District Assessment between Webster and Wright County in 2023. Motion carries.

Morris presented the following 2023 joint assessment with Franklin County:

JDD 111 Wright – 3 Franklin: total levied \$ 6,035.31, Wright County share: \$1,267.41.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevoid to approve the Joint Drainage District Assessment between Franklin and Wright County in 2023. Motion carries.

Entered into a conference call with Franklin County for JDD 100-2 bid letting.

Supervisor Richard Lukensmeyer (Franklin County) opened the Bid Letting at 10:30 am for repairs and improvements to Lower Main Tile JDD 100-2.
