**ORDINANCE NO. 184** ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF GOLDFIELD, IOWA, BY AMENDING CERTAIN

PROVISIONS RELATING TO SAL-ARIES OF MUNICPAL OFFICERS BE ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDFIELD, IOWA:

SECTION 1: Section 9.2 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Goldfield, Iowa (2014) is repealed and the following sections are adopted in lieu thereof:

9.2 MAYOR, Effective July 1. 2022, the salary of the Mayor shall be five thousand five hundred (\$5,500.00) dollars per year or \$458.33 monthly.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY. If any section, provision or part thereof of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its adoption and publication as provided by law.
