February 5, 2024

Chairman Helgevoild called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Rasmussen and Helgevoild with Kluss absent. Motion by Helgevoild to approve the tentative agenda. Motion carries. Minutes of the regular meeting of January 29, 2024 and special meeting of January 31, 2024 were read and approved. Approve claims for payment. In open forum, Bob Ritter stated that the ACLU joined in the fight against the SCS pipeline project. Also, there is an attorney that is working pro bono for landowners against the pipeline. Bob asked if the Board of Supervisors would be interested in speaking to her. He would line up a time. Also in open forum, Sandy McGrath presented a Health and Human Services Snapshot of the demographics of Wright County. This snapshot stated that Wright County is a shortage area for Primary Care Physicians and Mental Health Care Providers. With addictive disorders, 22.2% of adults reported binge drinking with 24.7% being the Iowa average. In Wright County, 69 residents received substance use treatment in 2023. 13.1% residents live below the rate of poverty with 11% being Iowa average. 5,680 are enrolled in Medicaid. 8 % households do not have a vehicle with 5.6% being Iowa average. The Public Health department will have the full report available. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoild to receive the monthly revenue report from the Wright County Sheriff. Motion carries. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoild to approve the liquor license for Nine and Dine pending dram. Motion carries. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoild to approve the liquor license for Oakdale Chapter of the Izaak Walton League. Motion carries. Motion by Helgevoild and seconded by Rasmussen to appoint Clark

Morgan to be the Troy Township Trustee with a term to expire December 31, 2026. Motion carries. Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer presented Resolution 2024-8 for the establishment of a 5-ton embargo. There was then a motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevoild to approve Resolution 2024-8 for the establishment of a 5-ton embargo. By roll call vote: Ayes – Helgevoild and Rasmussen, Nays – none with Kluss absent. Motion carries. Resolution 2024-8 duly passes and reads as follows: **RESOLUTION 2024-8 ESTABLISHMENT OF A 5 TON EMBARGO** WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 321.471 and 321.472 of the Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors may establish a road embargo on the Secondary Road System, and WHEREAS, inclement weather is producing a condition where heavy loading is extremely detrimental to the Secondary Road System. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Wright County Board of Supervisors that the County Engineer be authorized to order any of the Secondary Roads closed to vehicles in excess of five (5) tons per axle, wherever he deems it necessary and for the period of time deemed expedient (not to exceed 90 days), by erecting signs in accordance with Section 321.472. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer may grant permits of exemption upon a showing that there is a need to move to market farm produce of a type subject to rapid spoilage, or loss of value or to move any farm feeds or fuel for home heating purposes. Adopted this 5th day of February 2024.

Clemons then updated the board that the crews have been hauling sand in from Wright Materials to refill sand/salt storage piles. Motion by Helgevoild to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries. Karl Helgevoild, Chairman, Wright County Board of Supervisors Betty Ellis, Wright County Auditor
