

August 26, 2024

The Board of Supervisors met as Drainage District Trustees. To view minutes from the drainage meeting see the Drainage District minutes on the County website.

Chairman Helgevoid called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:05 a.m. Members present were Rasmussen and Helgevoid with Kluss present via Zoom.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the tentative agenda. Motion carries.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of August 19, 2024 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Brittany Howieson with the CDA Board updated the Board about the electrical circuit project in the Courthouse courtyard. The contractor that was originally hired informed Howieson that they will not be able to complete the project. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve \$4,664 in ARPA Funds which will be 1/3 of the cost from T & R Electric LLC and was the next lowest bid for the project. Motion carries.

Andy Yackle, Building and Grounds, updated the board on the costs for fixing the water issue in the Supervisors Board room from the rains in July. Yackle had a quote from Midwest Foundation Repair for \$8,241.32 and then also had some estimates for core drilling and electrical. Yackle estimates total project cost will be \$12,000. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve to move forward with the project at an estimated total cost of \$12,000. Motion carries.

Then presented was Resolution 2024-25. A resolution for the addition of projects to be paid out of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) fund. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve Resolution 2024-25. By roll call vote: Ayes – Rasmussen, Kluss, and Helgevoid. Nays – none. Resolution 2024-25 duly passes and reads as follows:

**Resolution 2024 – 25
ADDITION TO ORIGINAL RESOLUTION 2022-14, 2022-35, 2023-19, 2023-44, 2024-13, AND 2024-14 TO APPROVE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT**

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, President Biden signed the 1.9 trillion-dollar American Rescue Plan Act and,

WHEREAS, Wright County applied for and has been estimated to receive funds for the American Rescue Plan Act totaling \$2,440,021.

WHEREAS, based on the distribution guidelines from the US Department of Treasury, the following projects have been approved for the use of said funds:

- Update the Courtyard Circuits not to exceed \$4,664
- Install drainage system in the Board of Supervisors Chambers not to exceed \$12,000

BE IT RESOLVED that the Wright County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the items listed and authorizes the Auditor to make these payments as they are presented.

PASSED AND ADOPTED this 26th day of August, 2024.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the liquor license for Top of Iowa Lucky Wife. Motion carries.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the fire-works permit for the Wright County Conservation. Motion carries.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, updated the board on secondary roads projects. His crews are still working on the 2024 dusting of the 2025 gravel segments, mowing granular and hard surface routes and when weather allows are doing the concrete patching along C-70.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
