Jeremy Abbas, Assistant to the Wright County Engineer, presented the final plans for project FM-C099(104)--55-99 on C32 west of Goldfield and on R33 for one mile by Woolstock. The plan will consist of a 1 inch mill and a 2 inch layer of asphalt. With permission from the lowa DOT, the job will go up to Highway 17 Right-Of-Way and also their radius. This project will go out for bid on February 20th, 2024. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve the final plans for project C099(104)--55-99 resurfacing with milling of C32 west of Goldfield to Highway 17 and R33 to the County line on White Fox Road by Woolstock. Motion carries. Abbas gave an update on the Secondary Roads. Crews are working on brush cutting in the Right-Of-Way, completing Boone Township last week and will move to Liberty Township this week. Rebecca Barret and James Varland with the Department of Corrections Second Judicial District gave an update. This district covers 22 counties. They currently have 60 clients, 50 males and 10 females in Wright County. Since 2020, they have made treatment virtual to the clients to do from their homes. Currently, the Second Judicial District has 165 beds for males and 16 beds for females for a total of 181 beds in the three locations (Mason City, Fort Dodge, and Marshalltown). daily cost for institution is \$107 and the daily cost for probation/parole is \$7. There was a 62% success rate of probation discharges in FY 2019 and 77% success rate of probation discharges in FY 2021.
