quirements completed. At the end of the contract, the salary will move to \$85,000. The vacation will follow the Wright County Handbook for the rate of 15 to 19 years of service, earning 0.81 days of vacation with 10 days to be carried over and an option for a 10-day payout. There is a 60-day notice to terminate the contract by both parties.

The Board held discussion on amending Ordinance #61 to establish a County Waterworks Enterprise and establishing rates in con-nections therewith. Darrel Steven Carlyle, Wright County Economic Development, suggest keeping the current rate and reevaluate in one year.
