September 30, 2024
 There was no action taken as Drainage District Trustees.
 Chairman Helgevoid called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:01 a.m. Members present were Kluss, Rasmussen, and Helgevoid. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the tentative agenda. Motion carries.
 Minutes of the previous regular meeting of September 23, 2024 and special meeting of September 25, 2024 were read and approved with one correction.
 Approved claims for payment.
 Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the Employment Agreement for the Communication Director position. Motion carries. The salary will be \$76,000 with an increase to \$80,000 after 6 months with all the training re-

quirements completed. At the end of the contract, the salary will move to \$85,000. The vacation will follow the Wright County Handbook for the rate of 15 to 19 years of service, earning 0.81 days of vacation with 10 days to be carried over and an option for a 10-day payout. There is a 60-day notice to terminate the contract by both parties.
 The Board held discussion on amending Ordinance #61 to establish a County Waterworks Enterprise and establishing rates in connections therewith. Darrel Steven Carlyle, Wright County Economic Development, suggest keeping the current rate and reevaluate in one year. The Board has asked to put on the agenda for next week for the first reading of Ordinance #69 to amend Ordinance #61.
 Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to appoint Brady Gose

as a Civil Process Server. Motion carries.
 Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to appoint John Rohrer as a Lake Township Trustee to replace Joel Sebby with a term to expire December 31, 2026. Motion carries.
 Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to appoint Tim Brooks as a Eagle Grove Township Trustee to replace Dean Nelson with a term to expire December 31, 2024. Motion carries.
 Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to appoint Dean Kluss to the Economic Development Board with Karl Helgevoid as alternate. Motion carries.
 Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to appoint Rick Rasmussen to the Emergency Management Board to replace Karl Helgevoid. Motion carries.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, gave an update on the Secondary Roads. There were 12 work orders completed last week. Blades were out weed whipping bridges and culverts last week and were pulled from their routes for regular blading due to dry conditions. Trucks continue to haul for the dusting of the 2025 gravel miles with 113 of 122 segments completed. The Bridge crew completed the night drive last Thursday evening and will need to review with the Sign Foreman to see if any signs will need to be replaced.

Constitutional Amendment
 Shall the following amendment to the Constitution be adopted?
 1
 Summary: Provides for only U.S. citizens aged 18 or older and meeting state and county residency requirements to vote in all elections. Further provides that 17-year-olds who will be 18 years old by the General Election are eligible to vote in the primary election, subject to the same citizenship and residency requirements.
 Full Text: Section 1 of Article II of the Constitution of the State of Iowa, as amended by the amendment of 1970, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
 Section 1. Electors. Only a citizen of the United States of the age of eighteen years, who shall have been a resident of this state for such period of time as shall be provided by law and of the county in which the citizen claims the citizen's vote for such period of time as shall be provided by law, shall be entitled to vote at all elections which are authorized by law. However, for purposes of a primary election, a United States citizen must be at least eighteen years of age as of the next general election following the primary election. The required periods of residence shall not exceed six months in this state and sixty days in the county.

Constitutional Amendment
 Shall the following amendment to the Constitution be adopted?
 2
 Summary: Provides that the lieutenant governor will act as the governor if there is a temporary disability of the governor. Further provides that the lieutenant governor or lieutenant governor-elect will be the governor or governor-elect in the case of the resignation, death, or permanent disability of the governor or governor-elect thus creating a vacancy in the office of lieutenant governor or lieutenant governor-elect, as appropriate.
 Full Text: Section 17 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
 Sec. 17. Lieutenant governor or lieutenant governor-elect to become or act as governor or governor-elect. If there is a temporary disability of the governor, the lieutenant governor shall act as governor until the disability is removed, or the governor dies, resigns, or is removed from office. In case of the death, resignation, or removal from office of the governor, the lieutenant governor shall become governor for the remainder of the term, which shall create a vacancy in the office of lieutenant governor. This section shall also apply, as appropriate, to the governor-elect and the lieutenant governor-elect.
