Agribusiness Urban Renewal Agribusiness Debt Service Revenues were increased by \$583,068. 7,716 -238,494 Passed and approved this 29th of April, 2024. Jeremy Abbas, Planning & Zoning Coordinator, presented the recommendation to adopt Ordinance #68, Wright County Floodplain Management, to repeal and replace Ordinance #47 which was completed in 2013. This is a

Ordinance #68 passes.
Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, gave an update on the Secondary Roads. There were 8 work orders completed last week. Two of the work orders were special projects working with different size rock, ¾" and 1". All road personnel completed 8 hours of MSHA training that is needed to enter rock quarries when mining. This is something that is required every year. The beams for the C70 bridge will arrive on Thursday and will be set if there is no rain and lightening.

Rasmussen read a thank you letter from Upper Des Moines Opportunity for the Boards fiscal year contribution.

Rasmussen received a call from Humboldt County that they are needing assistance with their Environmental Health department. Sandy McGrath, Environmental Health Director, mentioned that she assisted them in the past as well. McGrath will invoice Humboldt County for her time and mileage and Humboldt County will reimburse Wright County. Rasmussen and McGrath will sit down and discuss details.
