PUBLIC NOTICE Wright County Minutes and Claims

APRIL 26, 2021

Chairman Pro-tem Kluss called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss and Rasmussen, with Helgevold absent.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment. Sandy McGrath with Wright County Public Health gave an update on the COVID cases in Wright County. There is currently 1,812 positive cases since March 2020. Over 9,300 vaccinations have been administered in Wright County with 34.5% of Wright County residents being vaccinated. At the Board of Health meeting last Tuesday the mask mandate was lifted. McGrath stated that most of the high risk and elderly have been vaccinated and they do emphasize that mask works and may still wear them to protect yourself and others. Clinic times are still from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Individuals can sign up on the Wright County Public Health webpage or by calling and scheduling a time.

Reviewed abatement order #1197 prepared as per district court order on a parcel in Belmond Township. Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the abatement of order #1197 on parcel # 03-15-300-005 per district court order. Motion carries.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to receive the guarterly revenue report from the Wright County Recorder. Motion carries.

Review the request for a generator for the Wright County Courthouse. This would provide continuous power for the courthouse during inclement weather when there is a loss of electricity. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the purchase of a generator for the courthouse as per estimate provided of about \$45,000. Motion

Peggy Schluttenhofer, Wright County Treasurer, presented a pay-roll adjustment for Amy Krueger in the Treasurer's office adjusting her wage to \$40,000 effective on the May 7th Payroll. Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the payroll adjustment for Amy Krueger. Motion carries.

Reviewed the Franklin/Wright County CICS Statement of Understanding for shared employee. In short the understanding will exchange work the employee will do for Wright County for rent from CICS for space in the Wright County Resource Center. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the Statement of Understanding with Franklin County for the CICS Employee. Motion carries.

Shari Plagge, Wright County Assessor, presented the Property Tax Exemptions for Slough Bills. There were 2,868.92 acres last year and this year will be 2,917.62 acres These will be reviewed and applied for each year through the Soil Conservation Commission. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Kluss to approve the property tax exemption for the slough bills applications. Motion carries.

Adam Clemons, Wright County

anticipated, will be available at the hearing.

Secondary Road projects. They have about 125 work orders left for 2020. Next week the road crew will move to 4 - 10 hour days.

Clemons presented a spread-sheet that showed the 5 year culvert projects for local forces + steel bent. The county will spend about \$200,000 to \$300,000 of local funds per year on these projects.

Elizabeth Thyer with Gardiner + Company met with the board to give an update on the Wright County Audit. This is the first year Gardiner + Company is doing the audit for Wright County after several years of a different CPA Firm doing the work. Thyer went over the Audit book with the Board and explained all the different sections of the audit. Then she covered the findings related to the financial statements and explained the expectations and the Auditor's recommendation on the compliance with the findings.

Ivan Droessler, ISG Engineer and Cole Budach, ISG Engineer met with the Board, acting as drainage district Trustees for DD #16. Droessler (Engineer) provided a handout that included 4 maps that illustrated the southern tip of DD 15 with flow paths; Overall map of DD 15, DD 16, DD 94, and DD 53; DD 16 Engineer's Plat Map from 1981; and DD 15 Engineer's Plat Map from 1968. He continued to give an update on land currently lying within DD 16 that was found, through their investigation, to have flow paths to the DD 15 Open Ditch. Droessler stated that there was an annexation of land being considered by the City of Eagle Grove Counsel as Trustees of DD 15 but the annexation proceedings were dismissed with no annexation action taken.

Droessler suggested if DD 16 was not reclassified in 1981 that a reclassification should be done. He was unsure as to why the district boundary lines between DD 15 and DD 16 were set to the middle of the Open Ditch when the districts were established since the flow paths do not support the Original Engineer's Plat Maps.

Auditor Ellis asked if we would be supplied with updated Engineer's Plat Maps for DD 15 and DD 94. Budach (Engineer) stated that updated Assessment Schedules were sent by email. Droessler finished up the meeting recommending that DD 16 be adjusted to reduce the acres and units for the lands that overlap with DD 15 per the findings of ISG. No action taken at this time.

The Wright County Board of Supervisors then joined a joint drainage district #100-02 conference call with Franklin County. Present on the call were: Franklin County Supervisors Mike Nolte, Chris Vanness and Gary McVicker, Colette Bruns (drainage clerk), and Lee Gallentine (CGA Engineer).
Gallentine explained the visual

observation only findings. It was noted that there were multiple blowouts and sink holes found as well as a washed out head wall. CGA recommends televising the tile from Oakland Drive to determine the condition of the Main tile and where there may be root infiltration.

Wright County and Franklin County agreed to continue investion the area per the recom

mendation of CGA.

The Wright County Board then discussed the joint drainage district #118-4 engineers report with Franklin County. The joint boards met to receive the reclassification report on the Main Open Ditch, Lateral 2, and Main Tile, the Engineer's Report for the completion on repairs and improvements to Main Tile and Lateral 2 Tile, and the Engineer's Report for the Completion on Repairs to Lateral 2 tile. The joint boards set the public hearing for all the reports on June 14, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. and will

be available via ZOOM or in person. Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
