Motion by Rasmussen and sec-onded by Helgevold to approve the Wright County Cost Allocation Plan for 2022 and have the Chairman sign the certification statement. Motion carries.

Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve the Cost Advisory's Services, Inc. contract for 2023, 2024, and 2025. Motion carries. The contract will cost \$4,450 each year in the contract.

Motion by Rasmussen and sec-onded by Helgevold to approve the lease for Central Iowa Community Services (CICS) space at the Wright County Resource Center from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. Motion carries. Motion by Rasmussen and sec-

onded by Helgevold to receive the monthly revenue report from the Wright County Sheriff. Motion carries

Sandy McGrath, Wright County Public Health Administrator, presented the grant that was awarded for \$9,500 to purchase new pagers for the Wright Count Fire Departments. This grant was awarded through the Wright County Charitable Foundation.

Andy Yackle, Custodian, and Sandy McGrath presented the plan for the renovation of the Public Health building. This would be completed in two phases. The first phase will be all the interior offices and rooms and the second phase will be outdoors for furnaces, doors, and repairing the roof leak. Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to have Allers Associates Architects prepare a plan. Motion carries. This will cost \$15,000 to create a plan and new blueprints. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to establish a per diem rate of \$30 and mileage following the federal rate, per meeting for the Temporary Redistricting Commission. Motion carries. Motion by Rasmussen and sec

onded by Helgevold to approve Resolution 2023-22 for interfund operating transfers. By roll call vote: Kluss, Rasmussen, and Ayes – Helgevold; nays - none. Resolution 2023-22 duly passes and reads as

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to set the public hearing date for June 5, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. for the fiscal year 2023 budget amendments. Motion carries.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, gave an update on the Secondary Roads. There were 18 work orders completed last week. Blades continue to prep and level the rock miles as the trucks haul them. Crews are reclaiming granular shoulders on hard surface routes. The 310th Street rehab/ reclaim will start next week with excavators out this week digging around culverts and intakes before the project.

Clemons presented the names of the two new truck drivers out of the Clarion Maintenance Facility. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve the hire the names presented pending post offer, pre-employment physical/drug screen and background check. Motion carries. The starting wage will be \$25.44 per hour.

Clemons presented the detour agreement between Wright County and the Iowa DOT. There will be a bridge replacement north of the feed mill on HWY 69 and the detour will be using the Galt black top. This project is estimated for April 1, 2024 to August 9, 2024. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to have the County Engineer sign to issue detour utilizing C54 and R59 for the HWY 69 bridge replacement. Motion carries.

Clemons presented another detour agreement between Wright County and the Iowa DOT. This will be for a railroad crossing repair on the east side of Goldfield. This detour will use R33 up to C26 then down R26 back to Goldfield. This project is estimated for October 2. 2023 to October 8, 2023. Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to authorize the County Engineer to sign the agreement for the detour utilizing R33, C26, and R26. Motion carries.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Rasmussen to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
