Wright County Board of Supervisors December 19, 2022

Chairman Rasmussen called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss and Rasmussen with Helgevold present via zoom.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 12, 2022 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Andy Flagge, IT Director, presented Resolution 2022-40 to ban the use of TikTok on County owned devices for approval. Motion by Rasmussen and seconded by Helgevold to approve Resolution 2022-40. By roll call vote: Ayes – Kluss, Helgevold, and Rasmussen; Nays – none. Resolution 2022-40 duly passes and reads as follows:

RESOLUTION 2022-40

TO BAN THE USE OF TIKTOK ON COUNTY OWNED DEVICES

WHEREAS, On Tuesday December 13, 2022, Gov. Kim Reynolds issued a directive to the OCIO banning the use of TikTok on State owned devices and computers.

RESOLVED, in following the guidance of the OCIO, Wright County shall adapt the following requirements for use of TikTok on county owned or managed systems.

Wright County employees of Participating Agencies or contractors that perform work on behalf of Participating Agencies on Wright County-owned electronic devices are responsible for meeting the minimum requirements, including the creation and implementation of agency-specific processes and procedures to comply with this Standard.

The purpose of this Standard is to provide Participating Agencies with expectations for software usage restrictions.

Minimum Requirements:

Wright County employees of Participating Agencies or contractors that perform work on behalf of Participating Agencies are prohibited from:

- Using the social media platform at TikTok on all Wright County-owned government electronic devices, including business on be-

half of the Wright County;

- Using the social media platform at TikTok to conduct business on behalf of the Wright County on personal electronic devices; and

- Utilizing a Wright County email address to register a TikTok account.

Waiver:

A waiver to this policy may be granted at the discretion of the Wright County Board of Supervisors and Wright County IT department.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, discussed Bridge #210 being nominated for the Iowa County Engineer's Association Federal RAISE (Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity) Grant submittal. This grant will allow up to 80% of possible funding. The estimated cost to replace Bridge #210 is \$2.75 Million. There will be an agreement made with the Iowa DOT to put together the RAISE Grant.

Clemons gave an update on the Secondary Roads. There were 10 work orders completed last week. Mowing of the granular roads is now completed. There were three winter operations last week. Trucks went out on hard surfaces on December 15th and all personnel went out on Friday, December 16th and Saturday, December 17th.

The Library Association met to give an annual update to the Board of Supervisors. Chad Chapman discussed what the libraries have used the contribution for and their accomplishments. They are requesting a 3% funding increase for a total of \$140,618 and a \$1,000 stipend for technology to each library. This will be considered at budget time.

Dave and Roxanne Pogge asked for an update on the land bridge in DD 107. The work order was sent to McClure Engineering and currently waiting on receipt of the engineer's report.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
