Wright County Board of Supervisors August 29, 2022

Chairman Rasmussen called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Kluss, Helgevold, and Rasmussen. Minutes from the previous regular meeting of August 22, 2022 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Bob Ritter spoke on the resolution that ISG presented. The Board mentioned they are still reviewing the resolution after the ISAC meeting last week.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, and Jay LeFevre, First Gabrielson Agency, discussed with the Board about the insurance requirements for farmers performing construction work in the road right-of-way. If the farmers would like to work in the road right-of-way, they would need a requirement of general liability for \$1 million, which can be reached by a combination of farm liability and umbrella insurance, and medical payments of \$1,000. This would be for farmers doing work on the land they own or lease. Motion by Kluss and seconded by Helgevold to add an amendment to the work in the road right-of-way permit insurance requirement that allows farmers to do their own work with general liability

of \$1 million and medical payments of \$1,000. Motion carries.

Clemons gave an update on the Secondary Roads. There were 18 work orders completed last week including drain tile and intake work. Crews are mowing hard surface roads as well as crack sealing. Zone 1 is continuing spot shouldering east of Madison Avenue.

The Board met with Franklin County Board of Supervisors via telephone to discuss the claim for damages for JDD 118-4 along the Open Ditch where repairs were recently done to the ditch. The claim was from Richard Pals in Section 19 of Scott Township in Franklin County for damages to his fence line.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Supervisor Chris Vanness of Franklin County to approve the claim for damages from Richard Pals in the amount of \$4,427.28 contingent on a Franklin County Supervisor visiting the Richard Pals property and confirming the fence line has been repaired. Motion carries.

Motion by Helgevold and seconded by Kluss to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
