Chairman Kluss called the regular meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present were Helgevoid, Rasmussen, and Kluss.

First order of business was to give the Oath of Office to the newly elected officials. The oath was given by County Attorney, Eric Simonson to Betty Ellis, Wright County Auditor, Karl Helgevoid, District #3 Supervisor, Rick Rasmussen, District #1 Supervisor and Jason Schluttenhofer as Wright County Sheriff.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Rasmussen to appoint Karl Helgevoid as Chairman of the Wright County Board of Supervisors and Kluss as Chairman Pro-Tem. Motion carries.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting of December 28, 2020 were read and approved.

Approved claims for payment.

Sandy McGrath with Public Health gave an update on the current COVID Cases in Wright County. There are now 1,539 cases since March. Wright County will be allocated another 200 doses of COVID vaccine which will put them to 600 doses total to date. Currently, the county is in 1A status which will be health care providers. Then they will move to 1B status will be first responders, police, teachers and then 1C status will be 65 and older. McGrath is confident in the process and distribution of the vaccines and feels the process in Wright County has been working well. Allocations will be going up in numbers as they work through the status of 1A, 1B, and 1C classifications.

Eric Gjersvik with ISG gave a quick update. Reilly will still need to get a clean test on the water lines. The flume is ready to go but Eagle Grove has not opened the plug since the agreement has not been approved. The wastewater draft agreement between the Agribusiness park and the City of Eagle Grove utility board has been distributed for everyone to review.

Mitch Sadler with Sadler Construction and Jim Hosen with Ahlers Architects met via ZOOM to give an update on the roof projects of the Courthouse and Professional Building. Courthouse building - Today the window will be installed over the west entry and tomorrow the window on the south gable. This week will be completing all the millwork and gutter work. Sadlers will be able to remove all the fencing and walkway later this week. On the Professional Building, the steel panels that are missing will be shipped on Wednesday. Roof panels will be completed this week. They have about 2.5 weeks of work left on the Professional Building. The county will have IT fly a drone around the courthouse roof to get a close look at the work done.
