To date, \$55,400 of the CDBG allocation has been expended. There is a local obligation of \$354,213 committed towards project costs. To date, \$40,584 has been expended.

B. Explain how the need for the activities was identified. The need for the project activities is to address slum and blight conditions and stabilization of downtown buildings in business district.

C. Nature of and Status of the Activities. The nature of the proposed activities includes the construction of facade restoration/rehabilitation on buildings located in the downtown business district. Peterson Construction is the contractor for the work on the project. Work on the project is approximately 6% complete. There has been no change to the project beneficiaries as proposed in the request submitted to
